RESIDENTS PARKING

We are negotiating with the Borough Engineer to increase the number of residents' parking places.

One proposal, to extend the times during which parking on residents' spaces is restricted, has been turned down by the County Highways Committee. However, the Society will continue its campaign.

Our proposals for solving this problem have again been sent to the Borough Engineer. He has been in consultation with the Police who have undertaken to do everything they can to improve the situation while exhibitions are being loaded and unloaded.

REGENCY SQUARE TRAFFIC CONGESTION

The Borough Engineer has informed us that the temporary arrangements for preventing congestion at the entrance to the NCP carpark in Regency Square has been very successful. It will now be made permanent.

The scheme was originally proposed by the Society.

EXHIBITION HALL EXTENSION ST MARGARETS PLACE

One of the conditions imposed for planning permission for this development states that Mr Tanner, the officer of the Council responsible for health and environment must inspect and approve plant and machinery to ensure it is installed in such a way that it will not disturb nearby residents.

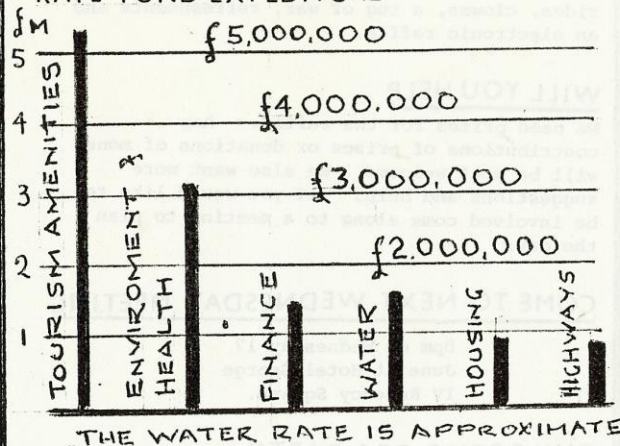

RATE FUND EXPENDITURE



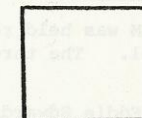
If members were interested we could organise a public meeting and invite our local councillors to discuss this question.

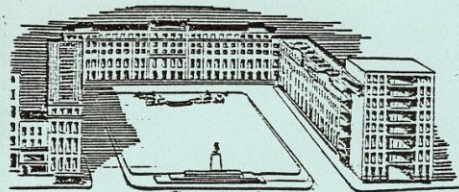
