

A BLOT ON REGENY SQUARE NEGLECT

Anyone walking through Regency Square at the moment is almost bound to notice one house in particular: it sticks out like a sore thumb.

It is number 63 which is located on the east side of the square. The house is owned by Brian Hare, a lecturer at Brighton Polytechnic.

Large pieces of masonary have fallen off the front of the house. Brick and wood are now exposed at the ground floor front. What is not obvious to the passer by is that the roof is also in need of repair: the top two floors of the building are unusable and damp is passing into neighbouring properties.

It is hardly surprising therefore that Mr Hare's neighbours have started to put pressure on him to put things right. So far they have had little success.

PUBLIC MONEY

Rooms in the house are let out to homeless persons. In many cases the rent is paid for them by the Department of Health and Social Security as part of the supplementary benefit.

Our chairman has written to the Department to point out to them the shocking conditions in the house and suggesting that they should reconsider their policy of using as a place to house the homeless.

The Department's reply was that it was a matter for the local authory (ie Brighton Council) to determine whether the house was fit for habitation.

40 PROTEST LETTERS


NO TO PLANNING APPLICATION

Meanwhile Mr Hare has applied for planning permission to divide some of the rooms with partitions in order to accommodate more people. Objections have been sent to the Planning Committee by the Society and by many local residents. Our local councillors, Feld, Nettleton and Smith have all expressed concern about the state of the building and are putting pressure on Council officers to find some way of forcing Mr Hare to Improve it.

Last week an article was published in the Gazette drawing the attention of the whole town to this blot on Regency Square and on Brighton's conservation areas.

Is it right that Mr Hare should receive public money to house the homeless and be allowed to keep his property in such appalling condition? This Society says NO.
