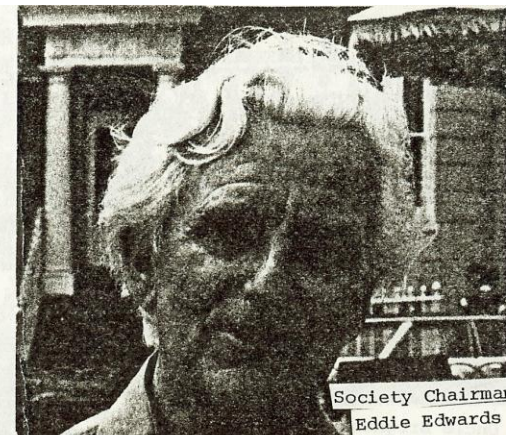

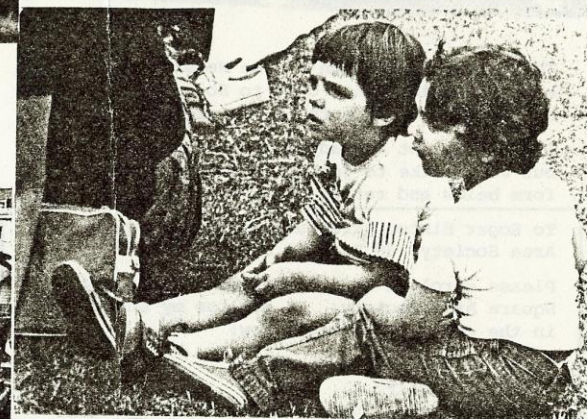
Last but not least, a thank you to the party organising committee for all the hard work they put in to planning a very successful day.



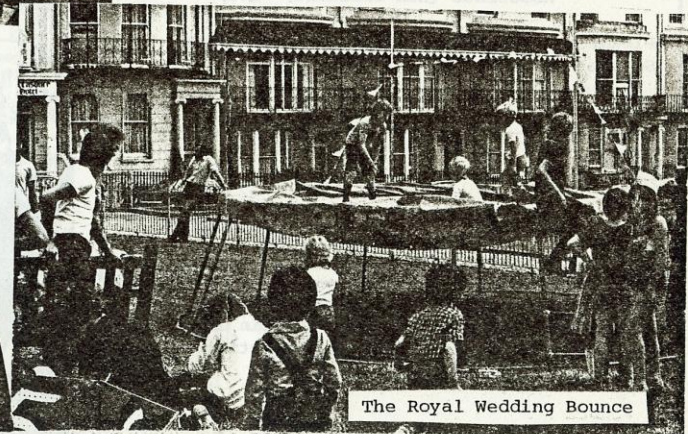
